The purpose of the project is to lay a foundation for future restoration actions by completing a Programmatic Environmental Assessment (PEA) for targeted restoration within the Trinity River watershed. Restoration projects tiered to the PEA will focus primarily on the tributaries of the Trinity River but could target other watershed areas as well.
