This road was located in Chanchelulla Gulch a tributary to Hayfork Creek and terminated adjacent to the wilderness boundary.

The next slides are before and after photos of the excavation of 24" culvert at a much larger stream crossing Mile 0.37 of 30N16B.

All stream crossings are seeded/mulched with native grass and later planted with riparian species and mixed conifers.

This road was located in Wilson Creek a tributary to Hayfork Creek.

The TCRCDD was able to excavate a few remaining additional stream crossings on this road that were left untreated from a previous project and the rest of the road put to bed. The next slides are before and after photos of two excavations of 24" culverts at stream crossings and tree plantings in the fall of 2021

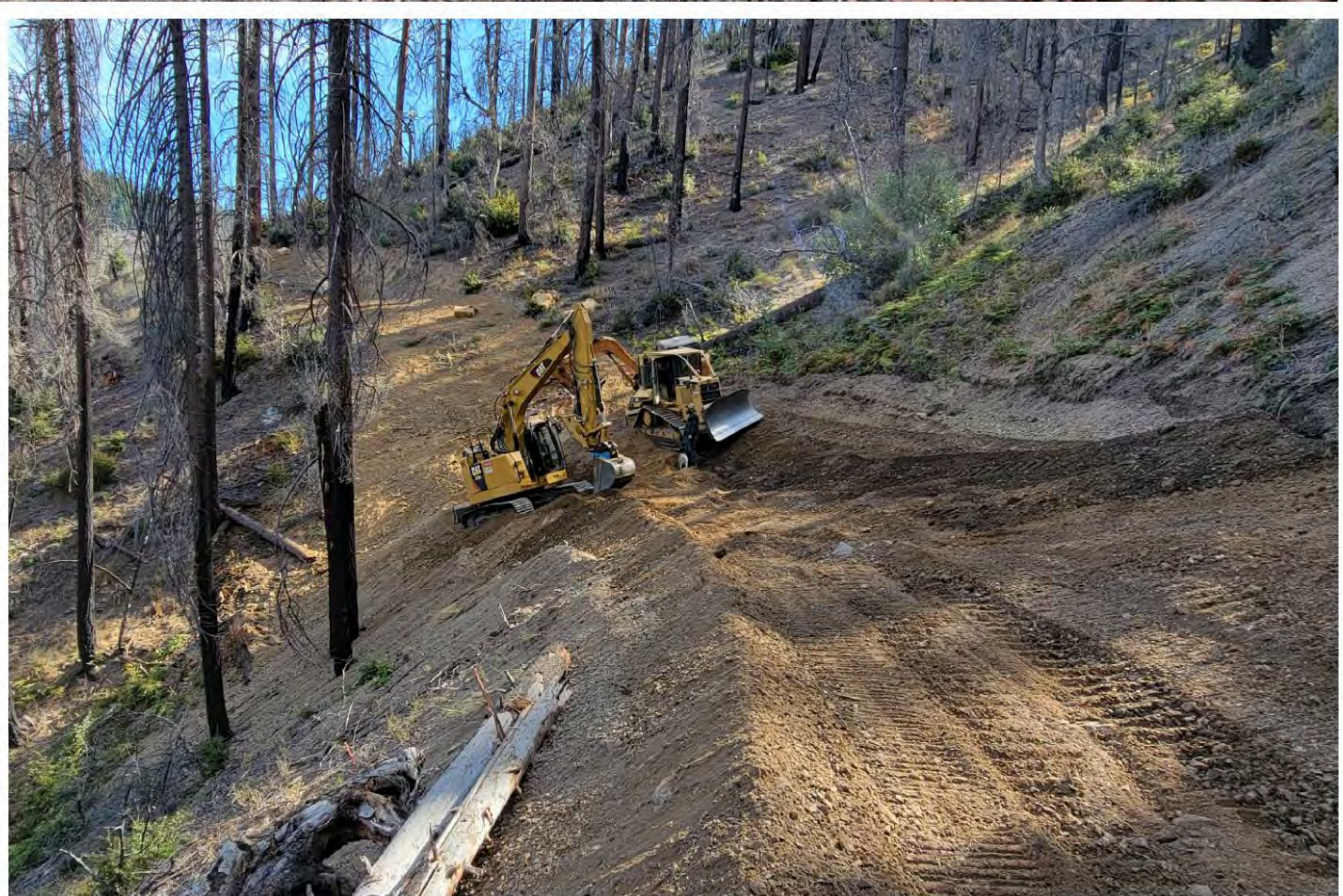
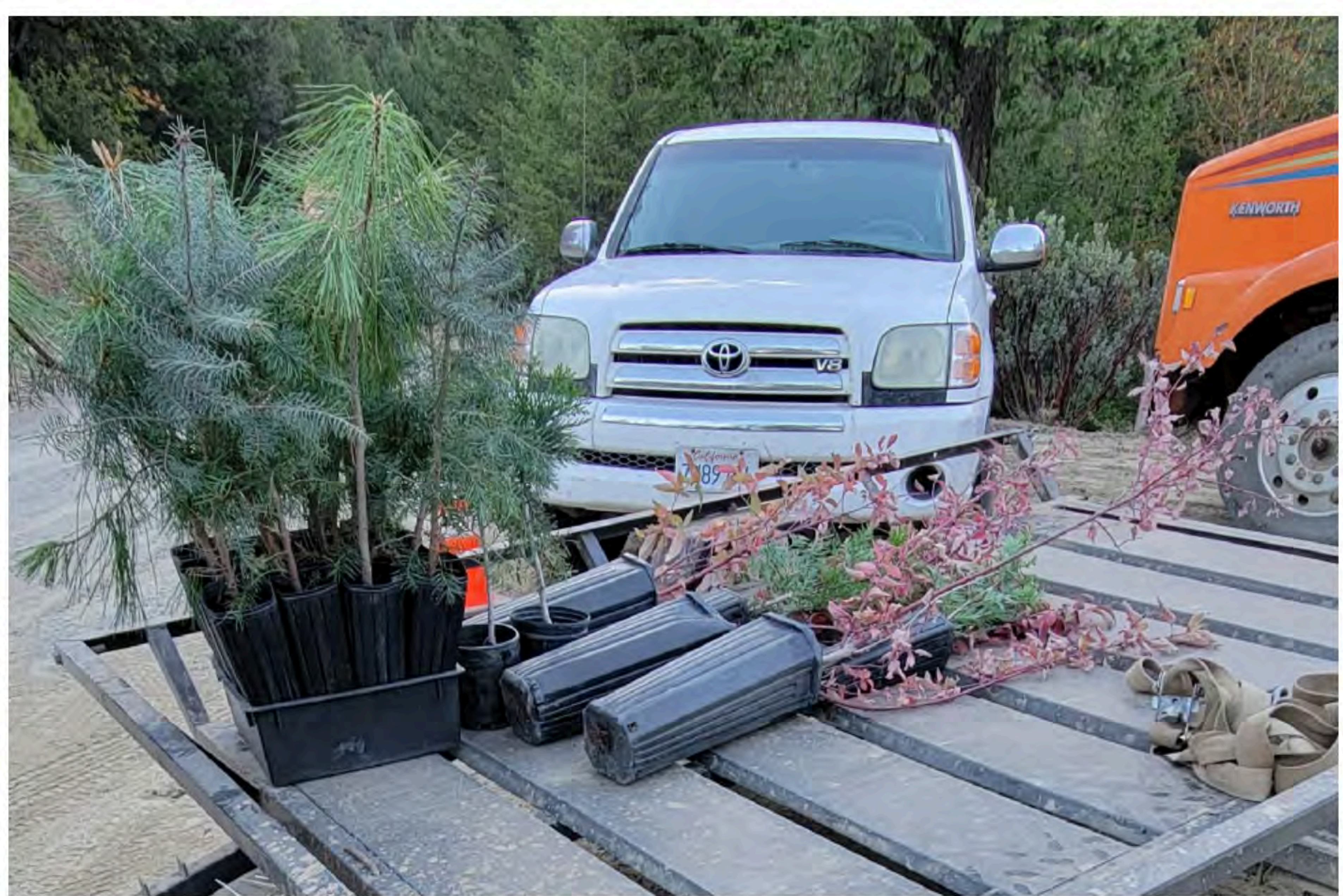
