

TRRP Information Repository: Inflow

(For IDT 2022-09-15 from TRRP Data Steward, Eric Peterson)

Per Data Management and Utility Plan (TRRP 2012)

- Information repository maintained by Weaverville TRRP office
 - All information funded by the Program
 - Additional information relevant to restoration of the river/watershed as practical.
- Website (DataPort)
 - Finished public products with broad utility (a subset of the full repository)
 - Nearly all reports
 - High-use datasets

All products must be submitted to Weaverville office staff to ensure appropriate review/approval (e.g. all government funded reports that could be publicly released have long been required to be 508 compliant).

- Science / Adaptive Management: Science Coordinator and Data Steward
- Restoration Implementation: Implementation Branch Chief and Data Steward

Please note: since 2012 TRRP contracts/agreements include a section on information standards that specifies that all information deliverables must be submitted to the Repository via Data Steward.

A few things that I check:

- Is there a clear product date? Title? Author? Agency?
- 508 compliance for reports. Easy for you to set title, author, and alternate text for figures within a word processor. Please structure tables simply and use the word processing tools to format as much as possible.
- Metadata for data deliverables. The goal is for the data to be described such that someone 100 years from now could appropriately do a new analysis on your data. For GIS, this should be in one of the standard formats. For other data I prefer a more narrative format and I have a template I can share.

Last note: for survey-grade positional data TRRP has a fixed spatial control network to enable change detection over time apart from plate tectonics. Ask me or Cort Pryor (Yurok) if you have questions.
