

TRRP Workshop Synopsis.

DATES	October 30 – 31, 2014.
LOCATION	Weaverville. The site is to be determined.
PARTICIPANTS	TMC and TAMWG members; TRRP staff
PURPOSE	A workshop is proposed to review the broad-scale scientific findings acquired since the 2000 Trinity River Mainstem Fishery Restoration Record of Decision regarding channel rehabilitation, flow management, coarse sediment augmentation, and watershed restoration actions. The purpose of this workshop is to build a common understanding among TRRP policy makers, stakeholders, and staff about the current condition of the river and fishery resources to assist TRRP policy makers in making informed decisions regarding the remaining channel rehabilitation sites, other restoration actions, monitoring and evaluation needs, and DSS development. The focus of the workshop will be to: (1) build upon the Trinity River Flow Evaluation Study (TRFES) recommendations, (2) synthesize the knowledge that has been gained during Phase I of the TRRPs restoration and assessment efforts, and (3) discuss recommendations of the SAB's Final Phase I Review Report.
THEMES	– Fisheries. – Geomorphology. – Riparian ecology. – Flow / Temperature management. – Channel rehabilitation. – Watershed restoration. – SAB review and recommendations.
TOPICS PER THEME	– New knowledge since Program inception. – Implications of what we've learned and TRFES assumptions. – Remaining knowledge gaps and uncertainties.
TIME PER THEME	Approximately 1.5 hours.
NEXT STEPS	TRRP staff is further developing sessions and identifying discussion leads / presenters.
