

Proposal Development Process for Monitoring of TRRP Channel Rehabilitation Projects

- (1) Design Team Work Group members are asked to submit preliminary monitoring proposals using the PROPOSAL SUMMARY form. Preliminary monitoring proposals may be submitted by others from outside the work group, but should focus on channel rehabilitation projects. Proposals shall be submitted and reviewed using the attached PROPOSAL SUMMARY form.
- (2) Design Team Work Group Coordinator (DTWG Coordinator) will assemble submitted PROPOSAL SUMMARIES and review the PROPOSAL SUMMARIES for completeness and clarity. DTWG Coordinator may suggest revisions to the submissions.
- (3) Design Team Work Group will review and discuss the PROPOSAL SUMMARIES during a regularly scheduled work group meeting. Design Team Work Group will first determine which proposals should be considered for funding, and then prioritize proposals.
- (4) IDT Coordinator/Acting Science Coordinator will review the selected PROPOSAL SUMMARIES to ensure that the proposed work is sound and that it does not duplicate other program activities. The Science Coordinator will ask for full proposals for acceptable PROPOSAL SUMMARIES. Full proposals will be required to meet the standards used by other work groups. Science Coordinator may ask others than the original proposers to prepare full proposals if it is judged that others are better suited to undertake the work.
- (5) IDT team will review final proposals and make recommendations to TRRP for acceptance and funding of selected proposals.
- (6) TRRP will fund selected projects subject to available funding.
