The Trinity River Restoration Program (Program) invites you to participate in the first scheduled public float of 2015. We will visit proposed channel rehabilitation sites in the designated **Lower Valley Suite** of sites, upstream of Junction City, and several completed projects. The float will take place from 9 am to approximately 2 pm on June 26, 2015, beginning at Evan's Bar and taking out at the Junction City Campground (see map insert below).

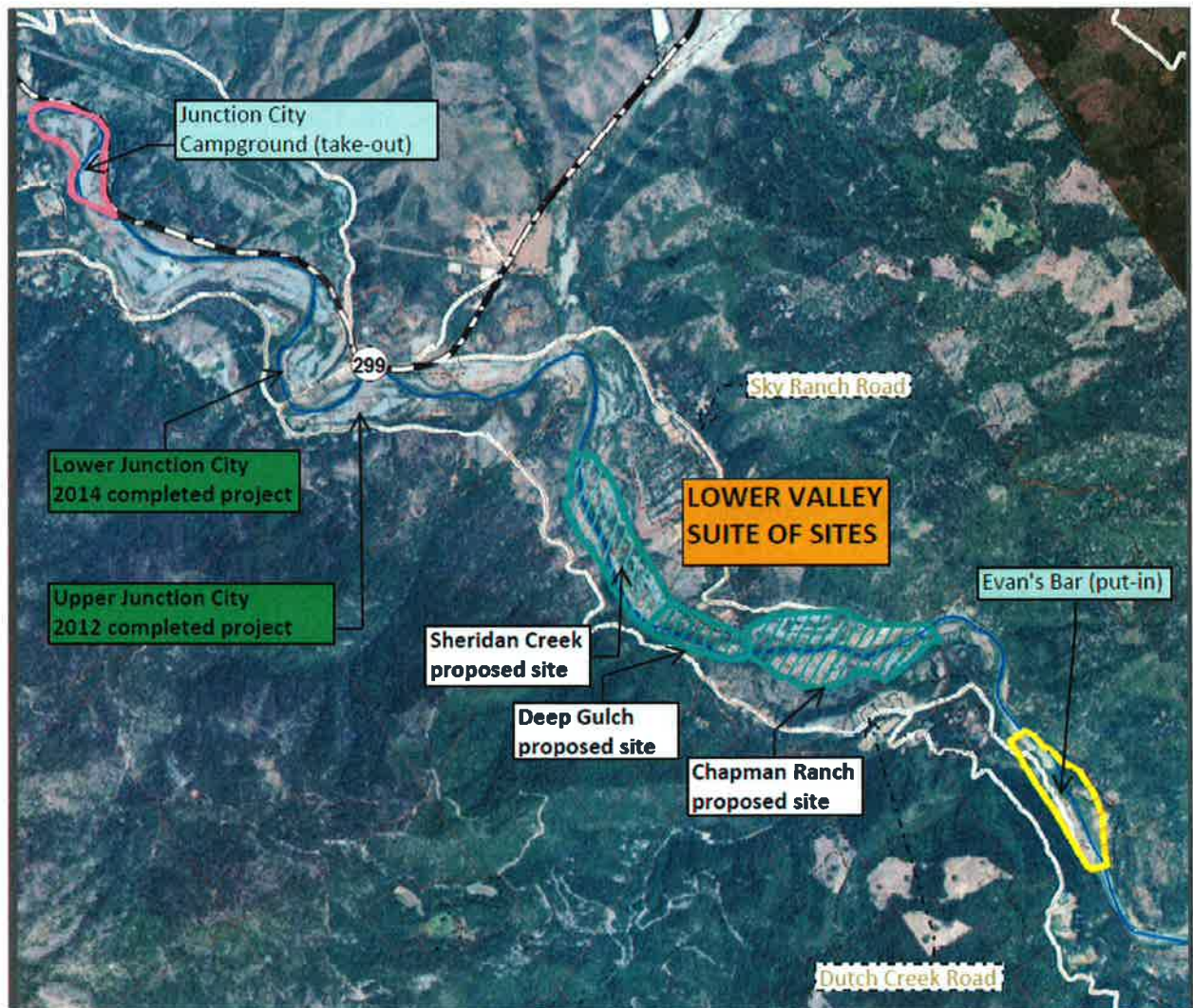

Landowners with property within or directly adjacent to the projects' proposed site boundaries will be invited personally. Design Team members involved in the specific project design alternatives will be present to explain proposed features and functionality, and other Program specialists in geomorphology, fish biology, riparian ecology, and Trinity River history will accompany the group to answer questions.
